- 1. Organizer** Japan Masters Wrestling Federation
- 2. Supported by** Japan Wrestling Federation and the Tokyo-to Wrestling Federation
- 3. Sponsor** Meiji Corporation
- 4. Date/Time** January 18 – 19, 2020 (Tournament on the 19th)
January 18 (Sat) 4:00pm – 5pm – Registration and weigh-in (#4&5 gymnasium)
January 19 (Sun) 8:30am – 9am – Registration and weigh-in (large gymnasium)
9:30am – Opening ceremony
10am – Tournament begins (no lunch break)

*Wrestlers must weigh in one of the two dates

- 5. Venue** National Olympics Memorial Youth Center – Large gymnasium, Athletic Building

- 6. Rules**
- A. UWW rules will be applied (two 2 minute rounds)
 - B. Single elimination tournament/no third place matches
 - C. Round-robin format for brackets with only 3 wrestlers
 - D. For wrestlers without an opponent, an exhibition match will be considered
 - E. It is a freestyle tournament
 - F. Both red & blue singlets, white handkerchief, and wrestling shoes are required*
 - G. Wrestlers must have a person available to sit in the corner for a match

***A red singlet and a blue singlet are required; handkerchiefs are required by rule for the wrestler to keep under his/her singlet during a match to wipe blood in case of injury; if you do not have singlets, please contact the organizer**

- 7. Qualification** See qualification requirements for each division below

- 8. Division/Class** A. Masters Division

Age Division:

Division A	Born between and including 1980 – 1985
Division B	Born between and including 1975 – 1979
Division C	Born between and including 1970 – 1974
Division D	Born between and including 1965 – 1969
Division E	Born between and including 1960 – 1964
Division F	Born between and including 1955 – 1959
Division G	Born before and including 1954

Weight Categories:

58kg, 62kg, 70kg, 78kg, 88kg, 100kg, and 130kg

B. Female Division

Age Division:

Division A Born between and including 1975 – 1990

Division B Born before and including 1974

Weight Categories:

48kg, 53kg, 58kg, 63kg, +63kg

C. Freshmen Division

Qualification requirements:

a. Wrestlers who has no high school or collegiate wrestling experience

b. Wrestlers with no significant wrestling experiences as a youth

c. Wrestlers who began wrestling as an adult

d. Wrestlers deemed appropriate for this division by the organizer

Age Division:

Division A Born between and including 1975 – 1990

Division B Born before and including 1974

Weight Category:

58kg, 62kg, 70kg, 78kg, 88kg, 100kg, and 130kg

D. Beginner Division

Qualification requirement:

a. Wrestlers with almost no wrestling or martial arts experience*

b. Wrestlers born before and including 1990

*Wrestlers must not compete in the division if he/she has already competed in the beginner division before

Match format:

1 or 2 exhibition matches will be organized with in the participants

E. Silver Division

Qualification requirement:

Wrestlers born before and including 1960

Match format:

a. 1 exhibition match

b. Participant chooses his/her opponent and registers with opponent

c. If you do not have a designated opponent, contact the organizer

For those participating in the Freshmen and Beginner Divisions

Should the organizer find that the wrestler does not meet the qualification requirements, such as the wrestler has significant high school or collegiate experience, not only the wrestler, but also his/her team will be suspended from participating in this tournament. Please understand the objective behind these special divisions of making the competitions in these divisions an attractive opportunity for those who truly qualify.

- 9. Special awards** A. Special award in recognition of wrestlers of the following age will be presented:
Those who turn 60, 70, 77, 80, 88 years of age during January 21, 2019 – January 19, 2020
B. 10th Participation Award
Those who have competed in the tournament for the 10th time

Those who wish to receive an award must indicate as so on the registration form

- 10. Registration** A. Non-Japanese wrestlers are exempt from presenting the JWF registration license
B. Masters, Freshmen, and Female must make their respective weight classes
C. Beginners and Silver Division will weigh-in

- 11. Awards** A. All participants will receive an award of participation
B. 1st – 3rd place winners will receive a certificate and a medal
C. 1st – 3rd place winners will be awarded right after the weight's 1st place match
D. Beginners and Silver division participants will receive a certificate after the match

- 12. Fee** A. Masters, Female, and Freshmen divisions – **5,000 yen per person**
B. Beginners and Silver divisions – **2,000 yen per person**
*Participation fee will not be refunded for any reason

- 13. Entry** Complete the online application form for the appropriate division from one of the links below. Fees must be paid via online by credit card payment (VISA, Mastercard, JCB, Diners, and American Express are accepted). No cash payment will be accepted.
